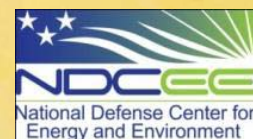

Dr. Fingar served previously as Assistant Secretary of State, and has held posts within the U.S. State Department as Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Analysis, Director of the Office of Analysis for East Asia and the Pacific, and Chief of the China Division.

Dr. Fingar received his B.A. in Government and History from Cornell University, and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Political Science from Stanford University. His principal languages are Chinese and German.

Dr. Fingar was awarded the 2005 Presidential Rank Award for Distinguished Senior Professional by the US Office of Personnel Management (OPM).
