The Intelligence Community Center for Academic Excellence (IC-CAE) - Intelligence Fellowship is a workforce development initiative. A highly selective program, the Intelligence Fellowship provides opportunities for students to integrate rigorous coursework, research, and mentorship in pursuit of a career in the U.S. Intelligence Community. Students will be awarded a Certificate in National Security Studies upon completion of program.

Program Eligibility

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have 60 completed university credits before the start of program
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must pass security clearance pre-screening

A Completed Application Requires the Following:

- Intelligence Fellowship Application Form
- Resume
- Personal Statement indicating why applicant should be considered for the Fellows program (500 words max). Please specify your interest in national security studies, research, and/or interest in employment with the federal government
- One Letter of Recommendation delivered in a sealed envelope.

*Program eligibility does not guarantee selection for the interview panel. Students selected for the interview panel will be based on an initial evaluation of a completed application.

The application deadline is FRIDAY, March 2nd, at 5:00pm.
