Key Findings

- **High Voter Engagement:** Over 80% of Latino respondents are likely to participate in the 2024 presidential election.
- **Mixed Outlook on the Nation:** While nearly 50% express concerns about the country's direction, these concerns are more pronounced among younger voters.
- Economic Concerns: Inflation and job security are the top concerns, particularly among older participants, with women showing heightened concern about inflation.
- Partisan Leaning: The Latino community shows a Democratic lean, with 48% identifying as Democrats, though younger voters are increasingly identifying as independents.
- Party Alignment: 59% feel the Democratic Party aligns with their values, but 32% believe they are better represented by the Republican Party.



Key Findings

- **Mixed Views on Immigration:** While 39% support stricter border control measures, including a U.S.-Mexico border wall, opinions on mass deportation are split, with younger and Democratic-leaning individuals showing significant opposition.
- Trending Away from Major Parties: Rather than moving from Democratic to Republican, the survey shows a trend away from major parties, especially among younger Latinos who are disengaging from traditional party lines.
- Support for Presidential Candidates: Vice President Kamala Harris maintains strong support, with 56.9% intending to vote for her, particularly among female respondents, compared to 33.4% for former President Donald Trump.
- Limited Impact of Celebrity Endorsements: Celebrity endorsements from figures like Bad Bunny and Taylor Swift have minimal influence on the community's voting preferences, as most prioritize policy over personality.
- **Growing Independence:** While the community primarily leans Democratic, there is increasing independence and a focus on personal values, suggesting evolving political engagement in the 2024 election.




Data Sheet Latino Poll October 2024

Geographic Coverage	 The sample was composed using a hybrid design, with a fixed number of cases allocated (Minimum 100) to all states. Three (3) states with the highest proportion of Latino voters registered to vote in the upcoming presidential election were randomly selected: California, Texas, Florida. In order to know the incidence of the Latino vote, 7 states, called "swing states" were included in the design: Michigan, Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Georgia, Arizona and Nevada. To make the sample more efficient, all states were given a fixed assignment - n=100 except for Florida, since one of the objectives was to inquire about the voting behavior regarding the Amendments that would be voted on in the 2024 elections. Once each sample was completed, the data was weighted according to the incidence of Latino voters in each state.
Sample Frame	Phone and email lists of Latino/Hispanic men and women living in the locations defined above, registered to vote, between the ages of 18 and older.
Sample Size	Initially a total sample of 1500 surveys was designed, resulting in 1605 effective surveys. The total sample size implies a margin of error +/-3.1% with a 95% confidence level for the states included in the sample
Data Collection	A hybrid methodology - CATI and WEB-BASED was used to achieve a higher response rate efficiently, as well as a greater representativeness of all the target groups of the study. The resulting proportion was Web-based (75%) and CATI (25%). The sampling frame of the live telephone surveys was the lists of registered voters with an approximate response rate of 18%. The source of the Web-based surveys included independent panels, social media ads, social media handles, and phones. In all cases, the corresponding link was provided. 55% of the people who started the survey completed it.
Questionnaire	The questionnaire was developed by the Latino Public Opinion Forum in both Spanish and English versions.
Field	The Survey was conducted by ASISA Research in 20 days, from October 3 to 26, 2024




How likely are you to vote in the 2024 presidential elections this year?






How likely are you to vote in the 2024 presidential elections this year?






How likely are you to vote in the 2024 presidential elections this year?






In general, do you think the United States is currently heading in the right direction or the wrong direction?












How would you describe the current state of the U.S. economy?








Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is doing his job?








In general, do you consider yourself to be a Democrat, Republican, Independent, or something else?






In general, do you consider yourself to be a Democrat, Republican, Independent, or something else?








If you are an independent, do you feel closer to the Republican Party, the Democratic Party, or equally close to both?






As a Hispanic/Latino, which political party do you believe best represents your values?








In your opinion, how often do the following situations occur in U.S. elections?






How good or bad do you consider the following systems for governing the United States?






In general, what is your main source of news about politics?






When it comes to political news (when you watch TV, listen to the radio, or read newspapers), would you say you get your information from sources in English or Spanish?






Do you prefer consuming media content (news, shows, social media) that focuses on issues related to the Hispanic community?






When it comes to political news, which of the following television networks do you trust the most?






Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Kamala Harris and Donald Trump?












Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of JD Vance and Tim Walz?














How motivated are you to vote in this year's presidential elections?








What is the most important issue influencing your decision in the upcoming presidential election?






Do you trust that the upcoming elections will be conducted fairly and that your vote will count?






