




How do you generally refer to yourself?




How important are the following issues to you?

How Important are the following issues (Only Somewhat/very important)











How important is abortion to you?



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
























Will the US go communist under Biden?

If Biden is reelected will the US become a communist country?






Will there be a fascist dictatorship if Trump wins in November?

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














